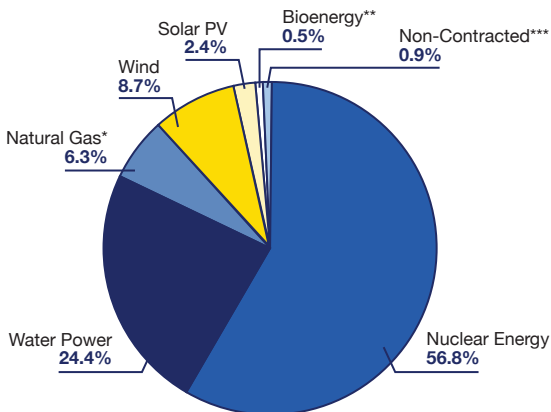


WHERE DOES ONTARIO'S ELECTRICITY COME FROM?

In Ontario, electricity is produced from a number of sources. The Electricity Supply Mix is the combination of power sources used to generate electricity for the province.

The following chart shows the 2020 supply mix for Ontario.
