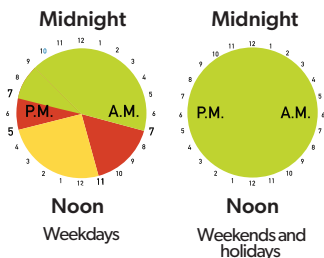


Electricity prices effective November 1, 2021


These prices will appear on the Electricity line of your bill and reflect the electricity you use.


Winter Time-of-Use (TOU) prices per kilowatt hour:

OFF-PEAK	8.2 ¢
MID-PEAK	11.3 ¢
ON-PEAK	17.0 ¢



Winter Tiered prices per kilowatt hour:

	Residential Above 1,000 kWh monthly: 11.5 ¢
1,000 kWh	First 1,000 kWh monthly: 9.8 ¢

	Small business Above 750 kWh monthly: 11.5 ¢
750 kWh	First 750 kWh monthly: 9.8 ¢

Effective November 1, 2021 the Ontario government's Ontario Electricity Rebate will be changed to 17.0%. The prices here do not include other lines on your bill, like delivery. If you have a contract with an electricity retailer, you pay the price agreed upon in the contract, not the price set by the OEB.

5 EASY WAYS

to **SAVE** energy and money this winter



Install motion sensors or timers in places you might forget to shut off the lights.

If you pay time-of-use rates, use your high-consumption appliances, such as washing machines and dishwashers, during off-peak hours.



Change your furnace filter every three months to help your furnace run more efficiently.

Use weatherstrip or caulking to seal gaps around windows and doors and keep warm air in and cold air out.



Use a programmable thermostat and set it to 20°C (68°F) when you are home and 18°C (64°F) when you are sleeping or away to reduce heating costs.
